Places Where People Live

There are three main types of communities where people live: urban, suburban, and rural. Each place is special in its own way!

Urban Areas

An urban area is a big city. In the city, there are many tall buildings called skyscrapers. People often live in apartments because there isn't much space for big yards. Cities are very busy and can be noisy. People might walk, take a bus, or ride a subway to get around. There are many museums, theaters, and big stores to visit.

Suburban Areas

A suburban area, or "the suburbs," is located right outside of a city. Many people who work in the city live here. In the suburbs, there are more houses with yards and trees. You will see neighborhoods with parks and schools nearby. Most people drive cars to get to the grocery store or to work. It is usually quieter than the city.

Rural Areas

A rural area is out in the country. There is a lot of open land and very few people. You will see many farms with animals like cows and horses. Houses are far apart from each other. There are no tall buildings or big malls. Instead, you might see woods, fields, and dirt roads. It is a very peaceful and quiet place to live.
